The March Maple

Matthew 3:13 “Then Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan to be baptized by him.” And life was never the same again! Jesus was whisked away by the Spirit for 40 days of fasting and prayer, then sent to gather disciples and begin his public ministry among the people of the region. “Follow me,” he said to a couple of fishermen, “and I will help you fish for people.” (Matthew 4:19)

A lot of action words are used in the Bible to describe our path of discipleship. Jesus called his disciples to “follow” which requires movement. It also suggests “mimicking”. The Scripture suggests that salvation is not a static state of being – it is a way of life, which is patterned after Jesus.

If someone were to ask you if you are a Christian, how would you answer? And if they asked you what difference does it make to your life that you are a Christian, how would you answer? A third question is the one I think is the most important: What difference does it make to your world that you are a Christian?

Jesus does not call us to just believe...Jesus calls us to follow. In this season of Lent, let us pray together as a church, that our ears would be open to hear what Jesus is saying; open our eyes to see what Jesus wants us to see; open our heart to feel what Jesus wants us to feel; and set our feet on the path that leads where Jesus is directing us to go. Let’s follow Jesus!


