What is a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)?

Good question! If you have an IRA and are required to take a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD), then it might benefit you and Morrisville United Methodist Church if you designated a portion of it as a QCD and donated it to the church. This reduces your taxable income by the amount you designate as a QCD and it is provided to the church untaxed. In other words, you are donating money that you might already be giving to the church before taxes and it also reduces your taxable income!! All women are welcome to attend!


